3 Name of the data file	Pirkanmaan liiton järjestämien tapahtumien osallistuja- ja asiakasrekisteri (Data file of participants and customers of events organised by the Council of Tampere Region)/Lyyti
4 Purpose of processin g personal data	<p>The processing of personal data is based on the data subject's consent, and the purpose of processing data is to process the data of persons who have registered for events of the Council of Tampere Region in event-related activities, such as the handling and facilitation of registrations, contacts, use of services, reporting and other event-related activities, always in connection with the event for which they have registered.</p> <p>The personal data collected in the data file will be stored as long as needed to facilitate the data subject's registration and the related event. The data will be deleted after the expiry of the storage period specified above.</p>
5 Contents of the data file	<p>The data file includes, for example, the first and last name of the data subject who has registered for an event of the Council of Tampere Region, their contact information (if any) and the necessary information provided in relation to the event. Data provided by the person who has registered for an event may include the following: title, organisation, e-mail, telephone number, address or information on special diets.</p> <p>Data aggregation with other personal data files: no aggregation.</p>
6 Regular data targets	The data file consists of data provided by the data subject.

<p>7 Regular data transfers</p>	<p>The data in the data file may be transferred within the Council of Tampere Region and between other organisers only in relation to the arrangements of the event in question. Information on special diets will be provided to an outside service provider without the person's name.</p>
<p>8 Transfer of data outside the EU or EEA</p>	<p>Data will not be transferred outside the EU or EEA.</p>
<p>9 Principles for the protection of the data file</p>	<p><i>A. Manual materials</i></p> <p>-</p> <hr/> <p><i>B. Computerised data</i></p> <p>Only parties who have the right to handle the data in their work are authorised to access the data system. The service is accessed through a web browser and secure HTTPS connection. A username and password are required to access the service. The data is collected in databases that are secured with passwords and other technological means. Deleted data is permanently removed from the data file.</p>
<p>10 Right to review data</p>	<p>A data subject has the right to review data connected to them in the data file. Requests to review data are served within 30 days, and exercising the right is free of charge once per year. Such requests may only be denied under special circumstances.</p> <p>Requests must be made in person with a personally signed form, which is available through the link below. The data subject's identity is confirmed before data is provided. The data is provided by a person specified by the decision-maker. <p>11 Right to demand correction</p>	<p>The data controller must, without undue delay, of their own initiative or upon the data subject's request, correct, delete or supplement any personal data in the data file that is inaccurate, unnecessary, incomplete or out-of-date in regard to the purpose of processing.
